

Control Tactics Minimum Course Requirements

This outline details the course concepts that **MUST** be covered during the training:

- Review Rules for Practical Hands-on Training
 - Students should remove jewelry, trim nails, & shower prior to class
 - No Live Firearms, knives, chemical agents, or other weapons
 - SAFETY CHECK -prior to start of class and prior to anyone new coming in
 - No disruptive behavior!
 - No horseplay!
 - Students must advise instructor of any injuries prior to, during, or after training
 - All students are safety officers and need to report hazardous conditions
- Review Basic Handcuffing Concepts
 - Nomenclature
 - o "Pistol Grip"
 - o "Double Push Principle"
 - Double-Lock handcuffs
 - Check Tightness
 - Officer Positioning
- Handcuffing techniques using a single officer and then with multiple officers
 - Standing Handcuffing
 - Prone Handcuffing
 - o Moving and Transporting Handcuffed Individuals
 - Removing Handcuffing
 - Choose an additional technique(s) approved by your department (e.g., gun retention, weapon disarmament, take-downs, ground escape techniques)
